

My name is Brittanie Mounce a mother of 4 and to one step daughter. Our story breaks my heart and I just want to give up. My husband has been fighting in court for the past 7 years. What he got was a visitation order and joint custody. But in a sense he didn't get visitation since the mother has been allowed to deny visits as she pleases. We just recently went to court, Friday Sept. 23 at 2pm at the Hills borough Superior Court. Prior to this he had filed an ex parte motion of course it was denied. Again he filed a few other motions one was motion for drug testing. He also told the court that his daughter is not living with her mother she is living at a campground in New Boston. When he went to court this was never brought up, the master I believe is allowing the mother to do drugs with no questions asked. To give up custody and forward it to her parents but that is I guess allowed in the State of New Hampshire. She is receiving back support for a daughter that never lived with during that time. We believe that she is being molested but again this was never brought. Nothing was brought up and was passed along as it is ok. I guess in the state of NH it is ok to molest your child and do drugs. My husband has filed motions after motions to stop the mother from denying visits. This master never once enforced the mother to follow the master's court order. We have seen my step daughter once for Christmas day in 7 years because this master won't enforce the laws on mothers. This mother keeps on doing what she wants since she has learned that the master will do nothing to her. We had 2 gals stating that she will continue to deny visits until this court stops her. Nothing we have not received any help from the courts.

All we ask for is to see these children. Mothers who deny visits should be jailed just like fathers. Visits pick up and drop offs done at a visitation center. That if more than 6 visits on either party is denied the other is awarded full custody. Or just have shared custody to all parents. This master did not care that my husband is going to school. She told him he needs to have 2 jobs to work 60 hours or more. How can going to school not be good enough? I can't believe this is allowed in the courts. Father's need help seeing their children.

I would like you to ask yourself. These children who are involved are being emotional damaged by being taken in and out of their dads lives. What are we teaching these kids? What is going to be the long range outcome of this damage to these children. These kids are our future and they are being treated like trash.

My name is Brittanie Mounce and this is only part of our story. We just want fairness in the courts. Why can't we have this??
