

I have had several experiences with the NH courts all except for one have been positive, as positive as a court experiences can be.

I have no choice after four years but to file a contempt of court case against him which means he'll go to jail and then I still won't get my child support. What does it take to get these men who choose to ignore the court to do what they have been told they must do.

I am very concerned about the expenses to go back to court and enforce a decision that the court has made but will not enforcing. What's the point of the court system making a decision that they basically have not intention of making good on and who suffers THE CHILDREN. I'm a single mom supporting three children on poverty level income and the court will not help me?????

I'm trying to figure out the challenges that I'm facing. I don't have time to figure out what *their* challenges are.

To tell you the truth I have not heard a lot of positive things coming out of the NH courts but I have heard horror stories about the negative things. I know because I'm one of those horror stories. One thing that I have heard is that the female judges that sit in one court in particular in this state are either afraid of men or have a vendetta against women???

In any case, I think that if the court makes a decision, that it is the duty of the court to follow through. The court is getting a reputation of allowing individuals to get away without any responsibilities for their actions. There has to be consequences. Jail is not the answer for these people, they don't care. Humiliation is the answer.

Please help the people who just want to do the right thing and make there be hefty consequences for those who don't. It shouldn't matter what the sex of the individual, what should matter is that the court has to stand up to these slackers. Thank you
