The New Hampshire Citizens Commission on the State Courts would like to ask you some questions about the state courts, including the

Supreme Court, the Superior Court, the District Court and the Probate Court. We ask that you limit your responses to experiences with the state courts and not with state or local police or other law enforcement agencies.

1. What experience do you have with the state courts?

Too much! I have had 3 state supreme court appeals filed (2003-0265 and 0323, 2004-0545), with another to go in this week. Within each is clear evidence of malice in the "justice system"- whether in the perjury of a police officer and the suborning of that perjury by the prosecutor plus a pattern of hostility by the judge in the underlying matter of 2003-0265, or the patterns of partiality, dishonesty, malice and threatening by the judges in the underlying matter of 2003-0323, 2004-0545 and this week's filing.

Of particular note is that my experience with a hired attorney was a disgrace (I fired
