

Below please find my responses to the questions asked in your survey regarding the Court System of New Hampshire.

The New Hampshire Citizens Commission on the State Courts would like to ask you some questions about the state courts, including the Supreme Court, the Superior Court, the District Court and the Probate Court. We ask that you limit your responses to experiences with the state courts and not with state or local police or other law enforcement agencies.

1. What experience do you have with the state courts?

My experience with the state courts (specifically Strafford Superior Court) has been of late, one of extreme bias against fathers and a total lack of concern for what's best for my Son. Although I my divorce itself was ruled on favorably by MM Nute (because my ex was repeatedly out of line in court and was told to be quite or she'd be held in contempt). However, because my ex didn't get her way in court, she chose to ignore court ordered visitation. Since she has been allowed to deny visitation for 8 months and even abduct my son from my house with no consequence's whatsoever by the 3 new judges I have had to face since. She has been allowed to lie to the court, (of which I have documented proof) with the court ignoring my evidence and refusing to hear from my witnesses. Not only did I lose most of my visitation but my ex was awarded monies she should have never been awarded. Even in our last hearing just recently, she was awarded 100.00 a month from my 929.00 a month disability check when she already received over 4200.00 and gets approx. 460.00 a month from my disability.
